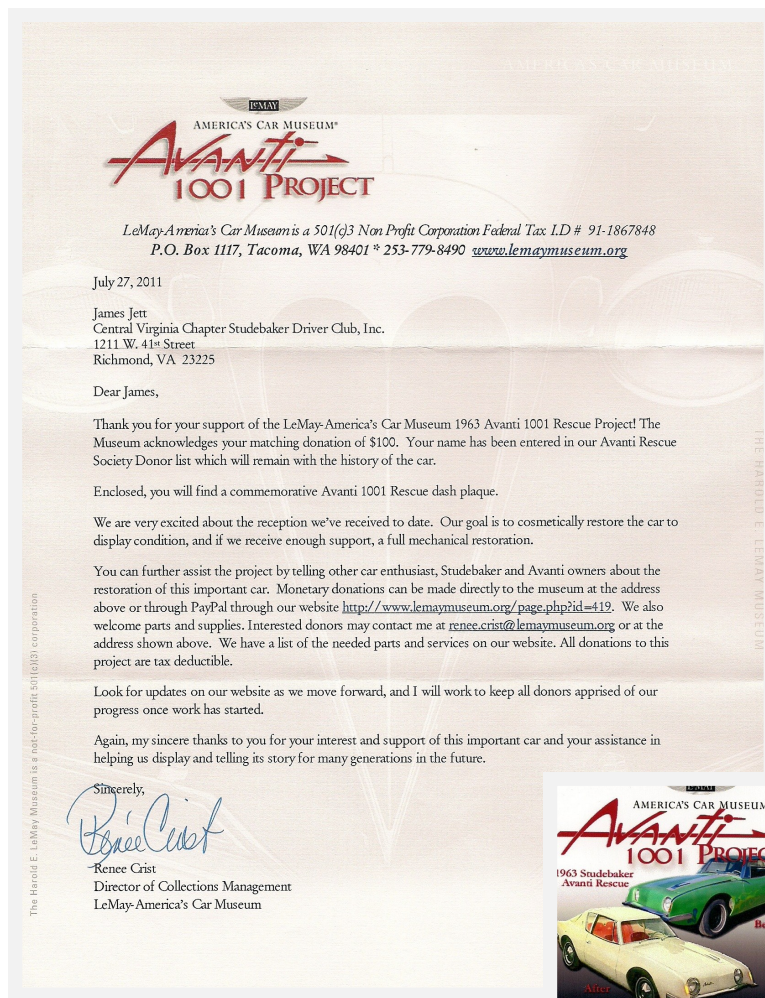
Both Herman and the CVC are now listed on the project donor page.

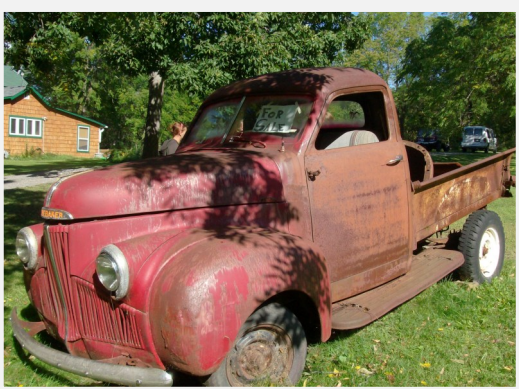

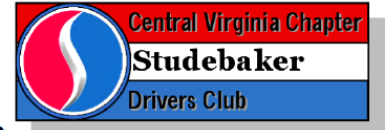
