

Fact 960: Pioneering Studebaker speed seekers were surprised to discover that 1955–1956 Cadillac Eldorado dual-quad intake manifolds can be adapted to the 1951-1964 Studebaker V-8 with only a small amount of effort (attachment bolt holes need reaming and hand-cut gaskets are required). It is one of the few happy coincidences in the hot rod world. Going the other way, 1950s hot rodders discovered the sleek 1953 Starliner hardtop was a perfect home for the Cadillac OHV V-8. Hot Rod magazine depicted many Stude-i-lac engine swaps and was directly responsible for spurring the Golden Hawk factory muscle package of 1956.





Fixing a Common Problem with Grease Zerks

Any place on your vehicle that has a moving part, such as steering components, bushings on rear springs, ball joints, ujoints, etc. will eventually need lubricating to keep everything looking nice under your hood: black stove polish. working properly. That's where grease fittings, also known as grease zerks or zerk fittings, and your trusty grease gun come Black stove polish liquid is designed to restore and preserve into play.

Most older cars came from the factory with grease fittings soluble and low odor. already installed. Most replacement parts also come with grease fittings. Some vehicles have plugs that need removing, It is best to start with a clean, non-rusted surface, so sand and grease fittings installed, in order to lubricate the part.





Advice: Get a Battery Disconnect Switch

My Studebaker has only one locking door and it's on the wrong side of the car. It's kind of a pain to have to lock my door, slide across the seat and get



Recently, while researching my options for a solution, I discovered a remote battery disconnect switch that comes with two small remotes.

The operation is simple: push the "off button" and the battery is electrically disconnected from the car. Push the "on button" and the battery is re-connected to the car.

The switch I picked is available through Amazon for \$22.98. Click here to see it: https://tinyurl.com/RemoteBattery-Disconnect.

It includes the pieces needed to fit batteries with the fat top posts or the small front posts.


Installation on the negative battery post was really straight forward with simple hand tools.

Connecting the red wire to the positive battery post completed the job; all in less than 15 minutes start to finish.

Now I can disconnect the battery with a simple push button and the car cannot be started without the remote.


Isolating the battery and denying anyone the ability to start the engine will give you confidence that whatever vehicle you've installed this switch on will still be right where you left it when you come out of the store.




